This Addendum No. 1 provides technical/administrative questions and responses received for RFP #19-002, as follows:

Questions	Responses
Under "The Robot must" you have: possess 3D mapping module. The mapping module is an accessory to the robot and not integrated into the system. Should I price the mapping accessory into the price of the robot or is that statement only saying that the robot must have the ability to map an environment if the departments would choose to purchase it later?	Additional line items have been added to Attachment C (Price Proposal) to submit pricing for robots with and without 3D mapping, video aiming device, and two (2) repeaters. Please see Addendum #2 and revised Attachment C.
Also in the same section item ix talks about a video aiming device. The video aiming device is an accessory for the PAN disruptor and not integrated into the robot. Does the price of the robot need to include the video aiming device or just be able to have an aiming device added at a later time?	Additional line items have been added to Attachment C (Price Proposal) to submit pricing for robots with and without 3D mapping, video aiming device, and two (2) repeaters. Please see Addendum #2 and revised Attachment C.
Under "IP Mesh radio with" it specifies up to 2 repeaters. Do the repeaters need to be included in the price of the robot or just need to have the ability to add repeaters at a later time?	Additional line items have been added to Attachment C (Price Proposal) to submit pricing for robots with and without 3D mapping, video aiming device, and two (2) repeaters. Please see Addendum #2 and revised Attachment C.
Under "Accessories to include" you have that you need 4 sample taking containers but then you only list 3 containers for the system. Which canister would you like to have duplicated?	This was an administrative error. Only three (3) sample taking containers are required. Please see Addendum #2.

<p>Would MWCOG be willing to revise the terms and conditions with the following language with regards to Attachment A - Contract Terms and Conditions, IX A.: “The delivery schedule shall be determined by the delivery date stated in Contractor’s proposal and the quality of the completed performance shall be evaluated based on Contractor’s ability to supply the specified goods by that delivery date”?</p>	<p>Agree to Amend IX.A.to state: The delivery schedule shall be as set forth in the Contract. MWCOG and/or members reserve the right to evaluate the quality of the completed performance by Contractor as required by the Contract; however, MWCOG and/or members cannot and will not control the means or manner of Contractor’s performance. Contractor shall comply promptly with any requests by MWCOG and/or members relating to the emphasis or relative emphasis to be placed on various aspects of the work or to such other matters pertaining to the work under this Contract. Contractor is responsible for determining the appropriate means and manner of performing the work.</p>
<p>Would MWCOG be willing to revise the terms and conditions as follows regarding Attachment A - Contract Terms and Conditions, XXI: delete last sentence and replace with the following wording “The Contractor shall be reimbursed for anticipatory profits which would have been earned if the contract had not been terminated”. Reason: the last sentence fits to a service contract but not to a supply contract.</p>	<p>MWCOG cannot accept this change.</p>
