2. On the Response Form, it says to include a Good Standing Letter. Where should this letter come from?

A Letter/Certificate of Good Standing refers to a certificate issued by a state's <u>Secretary of State office</u> (or comparable agency). It verifies that a registered business (e.g., an LLC or corporation) has complied with all of the state's rules for conducting business in that state. "Good standing" means that a company is up to date on filing its state reports, obtaining its state licenses and permits, paying its state taxes and fees, and complying with other statutory rules for operating the business entity. In short, a letter of good standing serves as proof of a company's business compliance status.
