Vision Statement: To reduce the rate of recidivism one ex-offender at a time. To create a safer community with fewer crimes and fewer victims

The Loudoun Aftercare Program (LAP) founded in February 2006 is a volunteer, faith-based non-profit that currently offers three programs to offenders and ex-offenders returning to the Loudoun County community. We are a program of the Loudoun County Adult Detention Center (LCADC). We work closely with Probation and Parole, District #25, Loudoun County Mental Health, and the Department of Family Services. We are partnered with Prison Fellowship Ministries, Inc. and coordinate our efforts with other local non-profits in the Loudoun community.

Our original and core program, Partner for Success, is our one year faith-based mentoring program where we match an inmate, with a mentor and a church. We currently have 10 churches in Loudoun County participating in LAP. Project Makeover is our post-release (faith-based optional) coaching program where a coach will work with a recently released participant to achieve specific goals usually employment or housing related. And Alpha House is our six month transitional housing program for men. In order to be accepted into Alpha House they must also participate in Partner for Success. All residents meet with a financial coach, life-coach and the house manager on a weekly basis.
