RESOLUTION ON AN AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2019-2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) THAT IS EXEMPT FROM THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY REQUIREMENT TO INCLUDE FUNDING FOR THE ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION IN WARD II AND PENNSYLVANIA AVE. SE STREETLIGHT UPGRADE PROJECTS, AS REQUESTED BY THE DISTRICT DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DDOT)

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), which is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region, has the responsibility under the provisions of the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the TIP is required by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) as a basis and condition for all federal funding assistance to state, local and regional agencies for transportation improvements within the Washington planning area; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2018 the TPB adopted the FY 2019-2024 TIP; and

WHEREAS, in the attached letter of February 21, 2019 DDOT has requested that the FY 2019-2024 TIP be amended to include \$7.6 million in National Highway Performance Program (NHPP) funding in FY 2019 for engineering on the Roadway Reconstruction in Ward II project (TIP ID 6493), and \$6.2 million in NHPP funding in FY 2019 for construction on the Pennsylvania Ave. SE Streetlight Upgrade project (TIP ID 6614), as described in the attached materials; and

**WHEREAS**, these projects are exempt from the air quality conformity requirement, as defined in Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Transportation Conformity Regulations as of April 2012;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the Steering Committee of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board amends the FY 2019-2024 TIP to include \$7.6 million in NHPP funding in FY 2019 for engineering on the Roadway Reconstruction in Ward II project (TIP ID 6493), and \$6.2 million in NHPP funding in FY 2019 for construction on the Pennsylvania Ave. SE Streetlight Upgrade project (TIP ID 6614), as described in the attached materials.

Dear Chairman Nohe,

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) requests that the FY 2019-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) be amended to increase funding for two projects as detailed below:

#### Project proposed for funding increase:

- 1. Roadway Reconstruction in Ward II (TIP ID# 6493) Increase NHPP funding in 2019 for Construction by \$7,592,000.
- 2. Pennsylvania Ave SE Streetlight Upgrade (TIP ID# 6614) Increase NHPP funding in 2019 for Construction by \$6,200,000.

The proposed amendments do not add additional capacity for motorized vehicles and does not require conformity analysis or public review and comment. The funding sources have been identified, and the TIP will remain fiscally constrained. Therefore, DDOT requests that the TPB Steering Committee approve this amendment at its March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 meeting.
