At its meeting of November 4, 2005, the TPB Steering Committee approved the following resolution:

RESOLUTION ON AN AMENDMENT TO THE FY 2005-2010 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) THAT IS EXEMPT FROM THE AIR QUALITY CONFORMITY REQUIREMENT TO FUND LEASING OF PARK-AND-RIDE SPACES IN LOUDOUN COUNTY AS REQUESTED BY THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (VDOT)

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB), which is the metropolitan planning organization (MPO) for the Washington Region, has the responsibility under the provisions of the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st Century (TEA-21) for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Area; and

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2004 the TPB adopted the 2004 Constrained Long-Range Transportation Plan (CLRP) and the FY 2005-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, in the attached letter of October 27, 2005, VDOT has requested an amendment to the FY 2005-2010 TIP to add funding for the continued leasing of park-and-ride spaces at a Lowes Island shopping center in Loudoun County as described in the attached materials; and

WHEREAS, this project is exempt from the air quality conformity requirement, as defined in Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations "40 CFR Parts 51 and 93 Transportation Conformity Rule Amendments: Flexibility and Streamlining; Final Rule," issued in the August 15, 1997 *Federal Register*,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Steering Committee of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board amends the FY 2005-2010 TIP to add funding for the continued leasing of park-and-ride spaces at a Lowes Island shopping center in Loudoun County, as described in the attached materials.

Dear Chairman Mendelson:

Consistent with the attached email from Loudoun County staff, the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) requests an amendment (also attached) to the FY 2005-2010 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Also included in this amendment package are a Constrained Long-Range Plan (CLRP) description sheet and a TIP description sheet for the project proposed for amendment into the TIP and CLRP.

This TIP amendment will allow access to \$280,000 in FY-06 RSTP funds allocated by the Northern Virginia Transportation Authority (NVTA) to Loudoun County for the continued leasing of parkand-ride spaces at a Lowes Island shopping center. VDOT believes that the proposed amendment is "conformity exempt" given that the proposed funding will permit the continued use of an existing park-and-ride lot, and, per Table 2 of 40 CFR §93.126, "Continuation of ride-sharing and van-pooling promotion activities ... " are activities that are "... exempt from the requirement that a conformity determination be made."

We request approval of this amendment by the TPB Steering Committee at its meeting on November 4, 2005.

Rahul, here are the details for the RSTP funding we were awarded for leasing park and ride lot spaces at Lowes Island:

The amount was for 95 spaces at \$35 a space per month for 7 years for a total of about \$280,000.

We are currently leasing 65 spaces at \$35 a space per month. The shopping center has the ability to give us 30 more based on meeting their zoning requirements. I don't have a timeframe when we will go to leasing the full 95, but probably real soon.

We have had talks with the new Catholic church that is under construction in that area as another alternative location for parking. We will pursue looking for other more permanent sites soon (once Leesburg is a little closer to being built).

I am putting in the interoffice mail the Lowes Island License Agreement.
