1. Community Outreach

2. Marketing and Public Relations

- **2014 Media Campaign** Clean Air Partners is in the middle of its annual media campaign. The campaign includes radio, online, and transit advertisements. The radio ads will run during the weeks of July 21st, July 29th, and August 4th on 4 radio stations in DC and Baltimore with a target audience of women 25-64 and adults 25-64. Online ads will run during the last 2 weeks in July on AOL and Huffingpost's websites. Transit ads run from May September on the following transit systems: WMATA, Fairfax County, and Prince George's County.

- **Social Media** Clean Air Partners held a Twitter Chat during National Air Quality Awareness week. The chat focused on air quality and health.
