What is the Coordinated Plan?

- FTA requires COG, as the designated recipient of funds, to have a Coordinated Plan guiding implementation of the Enhanced Mobility grant program
- Must be updated every 4 years
- Must include input and guidance from TPB's Access for All Advisory Committee and the impacted populations: Older Adults, People with Disabilities, and low-income
- Includes:
 - Unmet Transportation Needs
 - Priority Projects
 - Inventory of Existing Services
 - Competitive Selection Process
 - Strategies for Improved Service and Coordination

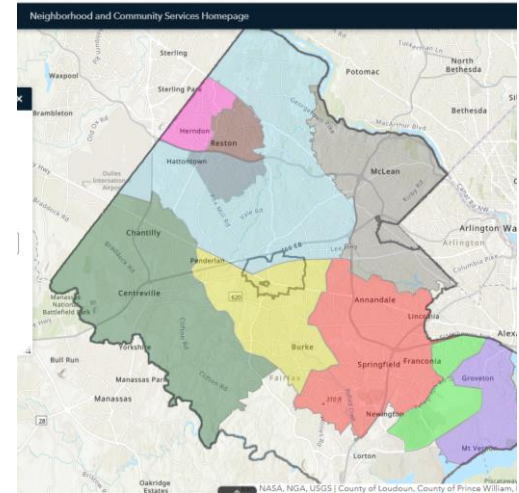


Public Comment Summary

- Public Comment period: April 13 to May 13, 2023
- As of April 26, 2023, Three comments received:
 - Comment considering policy language to support programs for improving accessibility to affordable and nutritious food
 - Update to *recharide* database entry
 - Comment with additional unmet accessibility needs
- Next Solicitation for Enhanced Mobility grant applications: Summer 2023
