#### **Selection Committee Process**

  - 4. Shawn Brennan, Expert on Aging
  - Melissa Gray, National Aging & Disability Transportation Center staff
- Follow up questions were sent to one applicant and consensus on funding recommendations was reached on December 17, 2019



#### **Selection Criteria**

Recommendations for funding were based on the following selection criteria:

Responsiveness to the TPB's Coordinated Plan:	20
Priority Projects (up to 12 points)	
Strategies (up to 8 points)	
Institutional capacity to manage and administer an	20
FTA grant	
Project feasibility	15
Regional need	5
Equity Emphasis Areas	5
Customer focus and input	10



#### Selection Criteria: Add'l. Considerations

Capacity to manage a federal grant

Successful past performance

Priority to vehicle replacement rather than expansion

Priority to vehicles and insurance rather than other operation funds

Equity in distribution of funding among jurisdictions

  - Outreach on available transportation options
