

Dulles Rail Phase I Bus Service Plan November 27, 2012



Background

- Plan based on recommendations from the Transit Development Plan (TDP) and defined by two different designs
 - The realignment, enhancement and addition of new feeder service to the new rail stations within Reston and Tysons Corner;
 - The implementation of a circulator bus system within Tysons Corner
- A priority for this plan is to provide linkages with regional transportation service providers and transportation modes



Service Plan Overview

- Goal: Increase transit ridership and encourage use of Silver Line by providing transit service to new rail stations in Tysons Corner and Reston
 - Addition of 12 new routes (Tysons, McLean, Reston)
 - Enhancement/Realignment: Modification of 17 routes
 - Elimination: Nine routes recommended for elimination







Proposed Route 434 (TDP)















Proposed Route 462 Option 1




Proposed Route 722 Option 1




Proposed SLC 1: McLean Option 1






Proposed SLC 3 - Greensboro












- August December 2013 (anticipated start of Silver Line service)
