

'help communicate about local projects in regional context'


- Infographics and Animated Videos

The Types of Information to Submit

Policy Alignment:

With what TPB Policy Priority does the project, program or policy align? How does it support that priority?

Impact:

- What challenge(s) was this project developed to address?
- What problem does it solve?

Top 3 top things

• What do you want people in the region to know about this project?

When and where:

 When was the project completed, or, when is it expected to be completed (looking for near-term projects underway)



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How Can We All Use This information?

- TPB and its members can use this for:
 - Internal tracking
 - Tracking Progress section planned for upcoming new Visualize 2045 website and in the plan update
 - Public Participation event we're conceptualizing
 - (summer activities to raise awareness help people 'see' our priorities in the real world)
