- Fairfax Not using and no plans to use in the future.
- Loudoun Not using, would like to learn more about how the program works and what projects are eligible.
- Arlington Not using, looking into it. QECB doesn't necessarily compare well to County Bond issuance, transaction costs issue. Uncertainty given no Virginia jurisdiction has issued QECB. Interest in possible bundling with other jurisdictions.
- Prince William Not using.
- Alexandria Currently not using, considering as part of upcoming bond issuance package in summer 2012.
- District of Columbia District is using QECB's to some infrastructure upgrades, lighting retrofits on buildings and monitoring for schools. Issued along with the General Obligation Bonds to reduce the transaction costs.
- Montgomery Not using, QECB doesn't necessarily compare well to County Bond issuance, transaction costs issue, administrative burden issue.
- Frederick County is not using QECB's; no plans currently in the works to consider using in the future.
