Following the 2020 Census, Fauquier County's urban areas were redefined and are no longer contiguous to those in Prince William County. Fauquier County is now entirely outside of the Washington DC-VA-MD urban area for which the TPB is the designated MPO. Fauquier County has opted to no longer be a TPB member, therefore the TPB must take action to adjust the membership and corresponding documents. The TPB will be asked to update the TPB Bylaws and maps to reflect this change.
