Selection Committee Process

 - 4. Deborah Fisher, Expert on Developmental and Intellectual Disabilities
 - 5. Heather Edmonds, National Aging & Disability Transportation Center staff
- Following staff clarification of eligibility and follow up questions for some projects, the committee reached consensus on funding recommendations on October 22, 2021



Selection Criteria

Recommendations for funding were based on the following selection criteria:

Responsiveness to the TPB's Coordinated Plan:	20
Priority Projects (up to 12 points)	
Strategies (up to 8 points)	
Institutional capacity to manage and administer an	20
FTA grant	
Project feasibility	15
Regional need	5
Equity Emphasis Areas	5
Customer focus and input	10



Selection Criteria: Additional Considerations

Capacity to manage a federal grant

Successful past performance

Priority to vehicle replacement rather than expansion

Priority to operating funds since programs hit hard by pandemic Equity in distribution of funding among jurisdictions
