The Technical Committee met on September 4 at COG. Seven items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on September 16.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 4</u>

The Committee was briefed on the TPB Citizens Advisory Committee's (CAC) proposal entitled: "Moving Forward With the Development of a Regional Transportation Plan." The Committee thanked the CAC chairman for his presentation and recommended that opportunities be sought for continuing the dialogue on financially unconstrained long-range transportation plans.

TPB agenda Item 7

VDOT staff briefed the Committee on additional ARRA funded projects in Northern Virginia to be submitted to the TPB for incorporation into the FY 2010-2015 TIP.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 9</u>

The Committee was briefed on Maryland Transportation/Land Use Connection (TLC) TLC technical assistance projects that have been recommended for funding utilizing additional funding under the Maryland Technical Program in the FU 2010 UPWP. The TPB will be asked to approve these projects its September 16 meeting.

TPB agenda Item 10

CSX staff briefed the Committee on additional details about the National Gateway Freight Rail Initiative to create a double-stack rail network along key corridors to improve the flow of freight between the Mid-Atlantic and Midwest. CSX has requested that the TPB support the initiative and the Committee recommended that the TPB consider providing a letter of support for this project and other similar projects that improve mobility in the Washington region.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 11</u>

The Committee was briefed on draft results of the Air Quality Conformity Assessment for an amendment to the 2009 CLRP and FY 2010-2015 TIP to Include the Purple Line Light Rail Project and the transportation components associated with the "Return to L'Enfant" Development Over I-395.

TPB agenda Item 12

The Committee was briefed on the draft final Regional Priority Bus Project

application under the Transportation Investments Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) competitive grant program of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). On September 4, the TPB Steering Committee was asked to approve the final application to be submitted by September 15.

• <u>TPB agenda Item 13</u>

The Committee was briefed on the continuing trial phase activities of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transportation Operations Coordination (MATOC) Program, as well as on ongoing preparations for full implementation.

One item was presented for information and discussion:

• The Committee was briefed on green house gas (GHG) emissions reduction results for strategies in the "What Would It Take" transportation and land use scenario, and on progress to date on the CLRP Aspirations Scenario.
