**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO AN URBAN
AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT AGREEMENT TO DEVELOP REGIONAL WATER
SUPPLY EMERGENCY OPERATION PLANS AND A BEST MANAGEMENT PRACTICES GUIDE
FOR WATER SECURITY**

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (Council) understands that reliable and safe drinking water supplies are essential for the health, safety, and welfare of the region; and

WHEREAS, the Council has a significant interest in regional water supplies and as such plays a key coordination role in enhancing the reliability, security and protection of the National Capital Region's water supplies; and

WHEREAS, the Council considers Homeland Security and regional water security and reliability as priorities and has resolved to act as a coordinator and key partner along with area water and wastewater utilities to address those priorities; and

WHEREAS, the Council established a Water Security Work Group to coordinate regional water security and reliability projects, and in that role has identified the need to develop regional water supply emergency operation plans and a best management practices guide for water security as a top priority and has sought funding to address these important needs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security has awarded an Urban Area Security Initiative grant to the Council to develop regional emergency operation plans and a best management practices guide for water security.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT;

The Executive Director, or his designee, is authorized to execute a contract(s) to develop an emergency operations plan and best management practices guide to enhance water security for area water utilities. The contract (s) will not exceed \$425,000 with funding provided by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. There is no local match required.
