


Current CASP Process and Projects

The CASP cycle has three (3) distinct phases each containing specific projects and milestones.



Regional Air Passenger Survey Overview (1)

- Provide observed data foundation for CASP program activities
- Current data to airports to support planning for airport facilities and services

J.S AIRWAYS

- Air passenger demand forecasting (ground access)
- Planning for airport access facilities and landside facilities
- Trend and market analysis

Regional Air Passenger Survey Overview (2)

- Survey every two years at region's three commercial airports
- Random sample of domestic and international flights during two-week survey period in late October / early November

- Passengers surveyed at departure gates while waiting to board flights
- Approximately 35% of surveyed passengers completed and returned a survey questionnaire


