Federal Rulemaking Update

- PBPP: Transit Asset Management
 - Agency TAM Plans – due by October 1, 2018
 - Group plans by DRPT and MTA for Tier 2 systems
 - FY19 Targets – due to FTA by October 31, 2018 (annually within 4 months of end of provider’s FY as part of NTD Report)
 - TPB will collate and develop regional TAM targets
- PBPP: Transit Safety
 - Public Transportation Agency Safety Plans rule – was expected in May. No further update
- Federal Bus Grants – FY17 Awarded, FY18 NOFO
 - WMATA: Bus Shelter Asset Replacement \$3,600,000
 - MTA (Frederick City): Bus Stop: Facility Improvements \$2,600,000
 - PRTC: Bus Replacement \$3,600,000
 - FY18 NOFO: \$366.3 million available, applications are due by August 6



TPB Transit Planning Activities

- 2045 Visualize Long Range Plan
 - Approval scheduled October 2018
 - TPB Endorsed Initiatives – Board discussion November 2018
- 2017 State of Public Transportation Report
 - Member survey forthcoming
 - Complete report by end of October
