Lei Zhang, University of Maryland, College Park

The University of Maryland has a newly funded Department of Energy project for the Baltimore-Washington, D.C. region, called iPretii, to study real-time travel behavior via dynamic traffic simulation. One objective is to develop a tool that can be used for both real-time and planning applications. The team would like to receive feedback from the subcommittee about data inputs and the overall development and possible applications of the tool.

**11:00 4. TPB's Unfunded Capital Needs Working Group** *John Swanson, TPB staff* 

At the request of the TPB, staff has been working since last fall to compile an inventory of transportation projects that are unfunded, but included in approved local and state plans. Since September, a working group has been meeting that is charged with overseeing the development and implementation of a work scope that will utilize the inventory of unfunded capital needs.
