11:10 5. Adoption of Policy Endorsing Energy Efficient Building Codes - Joan Kelsch, Chair, Intergovernmental Green Building Group

The Intergovernmental Green Building Group (IGBG), a CEEPC technical advisory committee, is recommending that CEEPC encourage members to send delegates to attend the International Code Council Meeting in Charlotte, NC, in late October, 2010 who would vote in support of "The 30% Solution," a 30% more energy efficient commercial and residential building code. States and local governments would then have the option of adopting the new standard. Grant funding may be available to assist with travel costs for this meeting.

<u>Recommended action</u>: Receive briefing; endorse IGBG proposal; identify grant funding for travel costs; transmit letter to COG members seeking delegates to attend International Code Council meeting in October, 2010.
