Sandra Brecher

Sandra Brecher is Chief of Commuter Services Section for the Montgomery County, Maryland, Department of Transportation. In that role she leads efforts to plan and promote use of alternatives to single occupant vehicle travel, to reduce traffic congestion, improve the environment, promote sustainable urban development and help address climate change. The office works with County employers, developers and property managers to incorporate Transportation Demand Management strategies; operates five Transportation Management Districts located in urban centers of the County; and operates two commuter stores.

As Shared Mobility Planner, Vicki manages the City's dockless mobility pilot program and Capital Bikeshare. Vicki previously worked at American University as Assistant Manager of Parking & Commuter Services and at Fehr & Peers in San Jose, CA.
