

  - Previous reports used difference sources
  - CoStar does not provide construction or project values
- Commercial Construction Activity
  - Completed Projects, not Starts
  - Office, Retail, Industrial, Multi-Family, Flex, Healthcare, Hospitality,
    Specialty, and Sports / Entertainment sectors
    - GSA owned and other government buildings are omitted
  - Focus on 2015 and also update for 2011 2014
