The Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments and ULI Washington are partnering to offer Technical Assistance Panels focused on identifying priority, catalytic strategies to maximize the impact of investments in Activity Centers. A Technical Assistance Panel (TAP) is a program where 10-12 senior-level real estate and land use experts work over a concentrated timeline to evaluate and provide market-based feedback on a local development or land use challenge. Depending on the issues being tackled, panelists may include developers, property owners/managers, investors, designers, planners, engineers, market and financial analysts, and public sector planners and officials. The panel takes place over a one-and-one-half day timeline, with a report of recommendations completed thereafter.
