## Event Planning: Volunteers and Registration






#### **Event Details**

- Items allowed:
  - Small engines (7)
  - Bicycles (5)
  - Jewelry (3- multiple items)
  - Clothing (3)
  - Small appliances and electronics (14)
  - Furniture (9)
- Not every item was fixed
  - 2 televisions, a tablet, and a blender

## **COVID Adjustments**

- Held outside vs inside
- Item registration vs 'first come, first served'
- No attendee-fixer contact
- No education/outreach tables
- Masks required
- Snacks and lunches served in individual packaging
