

TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights June 27, 2003

The Technical Committee met on Friday, June 27 at COG. Six items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on July 16.

TPB agenda Item 8

The Committee discussed potential goals and activities of the proposed TPB task force to examine how value pricing could benefit the Washington region. It identified several activities for the task force to consider, including identification of a HOT lane network, determination of regionally consistent pricing and operating policies and technologies, and discussion of the use of the revenues.

- TPB agenda Item 10

Staff briefed the Committee on the proposed activities and budget for the second year of the "Street Smart" safety education campaign.

TPB agenda Item 11

FHWA staff briefed the Committee on the findings and recommendations in the Joint FHWA and FTA Certification Review of the transportation planning process for the National Capital Region.

TPB agenda Item 12

The Committee was briefed by consultant staff on the status of the draft results and the key funding shortfalls identified in the financial analysis for the 2003 update of the Constrained Long Range Plan (CLRP). The Committee was informed that the Northern Virginia results were being finalized and that TPB staff would organize a meeting of senior staff of the implementing agencies to review the final results prior to the July TPB meeting.

TPB agenda Item 13

Staff briefed the Committee on the status of the air quality conformity analysis of the 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and reviewed the transportation control measures (TCMs) included in the draft regional air quality State Implementation Plan (SIP) and the transportation emissions reduction measures (TERMs) available for the CLRP and TIP. The Committee received the draft FY 2004-2009 TIP document for detailed review. Staff also distributed draft maps and lists that depict the major studies, major highway improvements, and major HOV and transit improvements to be included the 2003 CLRP.

- TPB agenda Item 14

Staff reviewed the status of the alternative land use scenarios for the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Study. The transportation subgroup will meet to identify transportation scenarios on July 8. The next meeting of the Joint Technical Working Group (JTWG) for this study is scheduled for July 11.

One item was presented for information and discussion:

Staff briefed the Committee on the draft Jurisdiction and Transportation Analysis Zone (TAZ) -level Round 6.3 Cooperative Forecasts of households and jobs. A presentation will be made at a future TPB meeting on these forecasts, which are the land use activity inputs for the 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP air quality conformity analysis and the baseline land use scenario for the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Study. The forecasts are expected to be adopted by the COG Board in September.
