 - \$57,500,000 (after set-asides)


Maryland NEVI Goals

- 2. Invest in Communities (ZEEVIC)






Alternative Fuel Corridors





Round 1 Program Goals:

- Maximize Funding
- Demonstrate early win/progress
- Targeted Investment:
 - Build-out specific corridors
 - Primarily focus on Interstates
 - Support MetroQuest results



Local Government Involvement

- Eligible for NEVI Formula Funding
 - However, ideal applicant for later NEVI Rounds -community investment
- Permitting
 - Coordination with applicant prior to their application submittal
 - Review permitting guidelines to streamline process for installation of EVSEs
- Site Identification
 - Identify areas eligible for NEVI Formula Funding
 - Identify ideal/preferred sites for EVSE installation
 - Community Investment
- Workforce Development
 - Coordination with State Agencies
 - Coordinate & Hold Trainings

- NOFO released March 14th
- · Applications due May 30th
- Focus on urban & rural communities
