


'Pool Rewards Follow-Up Survey & Program Review June 2011




Pool Rewards Survey Question: One a scale of 1 to 5 (with 1 being poor and 5 being excellent), how would you rate the ease of using the on-line 'Pool Rewards tracking system to enter in your daily carpool status? 85% rated the 'Pool Rewards tracking system between "Average and Excellent"





Pool Rewards Survey Question: Please choose the category below that best represents how much your monthly carpooling costs were during your participation in the 'Pool Rewards program (include gasoline, daily tolls, and parking). Nearly 70% spent between \$51 and \$200 each month. If we assume the high cost for each group (\$50, \$100, \$150, etc... and \$350 for the 'More than \$300' total), the average monthly carpool cost would be \$174.27






Pool Rewards Survey Question: - Please choose the category below that best represents how much money you saved monthly during your participation in the 'Pool Rewards program (include gasoline, daily tolls, and parking). 54% of participants saved between \$51 - \$150 a month carpooling. If we assume the high cost for each group (\$50, \$100, \$150, etc... and \$350 for the 'More than \$300' total), the average monthly carpool savings would be \$149.27

Pool Rewards Survey Question: How many miles do you drive annually with your primary vehicle? 80% of the participants drive between 5,000 to 25,000 miles annually.


Annual Miles Driven

Alternate Driving?






Pool Rewards Survey Question: *Did you split the costs with the members in your carpool?* \$58% Yes, 42% No





Pool Rewards Survey Question: What mechanism did you use to split the costs with the members in your carpool? 25% exchanged cash or wrote a check, 24% split the drive. Other responses included: shared parking fee, took turns paying gas costs, rider pays parking and tolls, split gas and parking costs. About 40% did not respond.


How Costs Were Split

Electronic Split for Fee?






Pool Rewards Survey Question: Do you plan to continue carpooling after participating in the 'Pool Rewards program?

98% Yes, 2% No



Pool Rewards Survey Question: Do you plan to continue carpooling with the same individual(s) in your current carpool? 94% Yes, 4% No, 2% No Response



Pool Rewards Survey Question: Had you considered carpooling prior to learning about Pool Rewards? 79% Yes, 21% No


Consider Carpooling Prior?

Value of 'Pool Rewards






Pool Rewards Survey Question: What changes, if any, would you recommend making to 'Pool Rewards for the future? 27% no changes, 25% Improve trip logging interface, 23% Allow more time to log trips, 14% Improve updates and communications, 11% Extend participation period. 55 Other responses included: provide payment quicker, allow users to select start date, create web based app, provide estimated payout while logging trips, add work from home, drive alone, sick, teleworking to drop down menu.



Pool Rewards Survey Question: - Which of the following groups includes your age? 85% of participants are between the ages of 25 and 54.





Pool Rewards Survey Question: - How many cars do you have in your household? 45% of participants have two vehicles



Pool Rewards Survey Question: - How many licensed drivers over the age of 16 live in your household? 61% of participants have at least two licensed drivers in their household


#of Licensed Drivers


Racial Background

Pool Rewards: A Snapshot of 'Pool Rewards Participation

- 214 Active carpools in the 'Pool Rewards program since July 1, 2010.
- 348 Active participants in the 'Pool Rewards program
- 47 Initiating carpools seeking carpool partners
- 175 applicants were rejected from the program
- 50 participants were paid though June 30, 2011 and 20 additional participants are eligible for rewards
- Goal = 1,000 participants to be paid
