7. Approval of Amendment to the FY 2003-2008 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to Include Funding for NEPA
Activities and for Preliminary Engineering for the Dulles Corridor Rapid Transit Project Requested by the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT)

VDOT, on behalf of the Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation (VDRPT), has requested an amendment to the FY 2003-2008 TIP to include additional funding for NEPA activities and for preliminary engineering for the Dulles Corridor Rapid Transit Project in Northern Virginia, as described in the attached materials.

Action: Adopt Resolution R2-2004 to approve amendment to the FY 2003-2008 TIP as requested by VDOT.

INFORMATION ITEMS

At its July 16, 2003 meeting, the Board approved responses to public comments on mobile emissions budgets and transportation control measures (TCMs) for consideration by the Metropolitan Washington Air Quality Committee (MWAQC) as MWAQC was developing an updated regional SIP. The Board will be briefed on the updated SIP that MWAQC approved on August 13, 2003 and that the states submitted to EPA the first week of September, on the schedule of activities for the revised SIP to be submitted in early 2004, and on the first meeting of the MWAQC SIP Management Task Force scheduled for September 12.

At the July 16 meeting, the Board was briefed on the status of the draft 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP documents and the associated conformity analysis, which are scheduled to be released for public comment on October 15, 2003 and adopted on November 19, 2003. The Board will also be briefed on a recommendation to develop and release interim CLRP and TIP documents for public comment and adoption on the same schedule. Federal approval of an interim CLRP and TIP would enable federal funding to continue for eligible projects in the event that a federal approval of the new CLRP and TIP does not occur by January 21, 2004.

> At the July 16 meeting, the Board was briefed on the final results of the financial analysis for the 2003 CLRP. The Board will be briefed on the funding shortfalls and policy issues identified, and on potential ways to address the funding challenges.

The Board will be briefed on recent coordination planning activities to expand transportation evacuation, protective actions and shelter-in-place sections of the National Capital Region Emergency Coordination Plan.
