At the September 17 meeting, the Board approved the development of interim 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP information to be released for public comment on October 15, 2003 and adopted on November 19, 2003 if the TPB adoption of the 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP is postponed. A conformity lapse will occur on January 21, 2004 if federal approval of the new 2003 CLRP and FY 2004-2009 TIP is not received by that date. However, federal approval of an interim CLRP and TIP would enable federal funding to continue for specific eligible projects.
