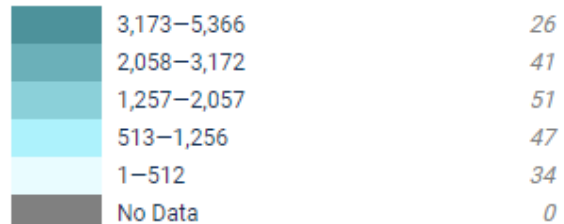

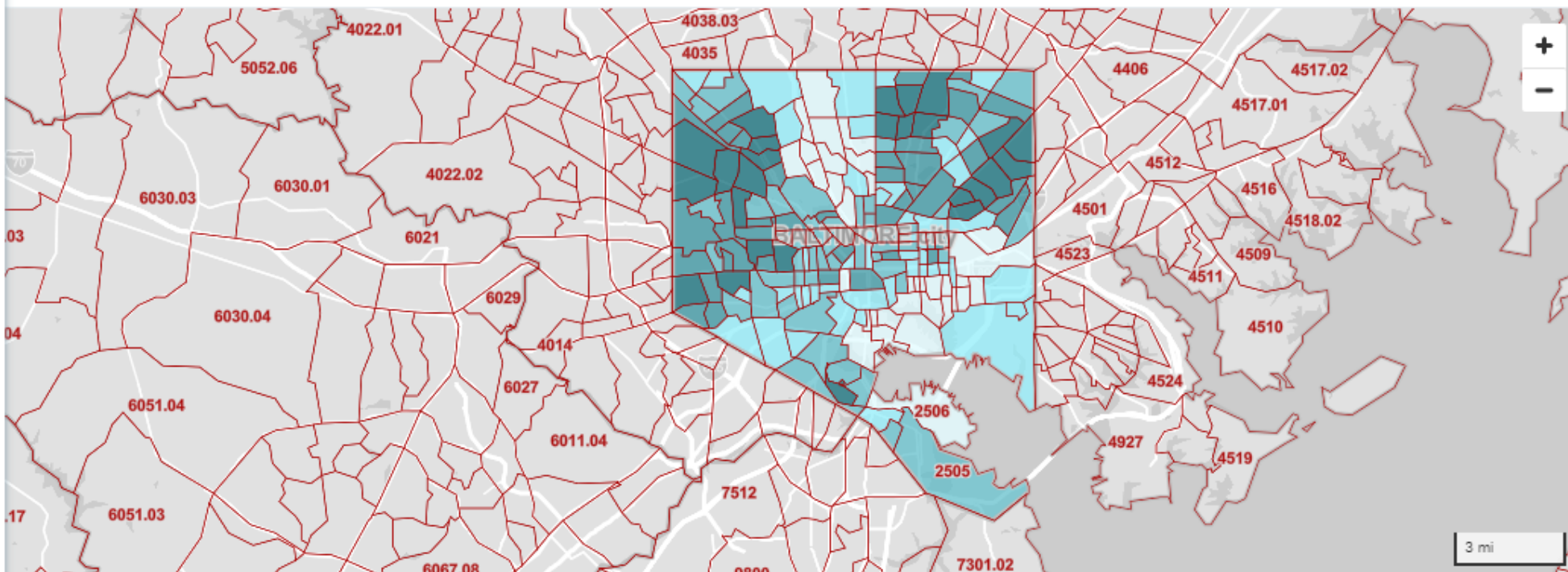

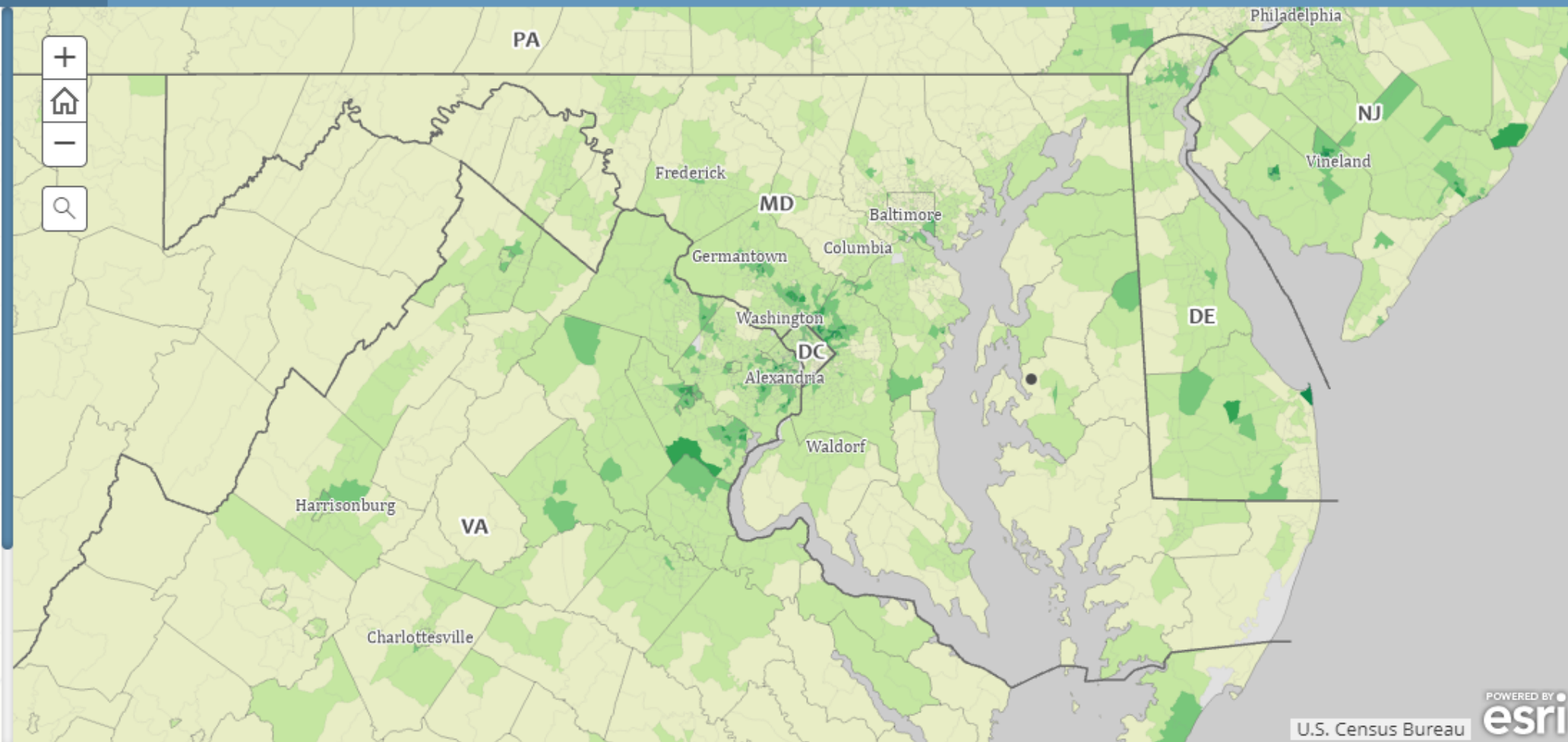

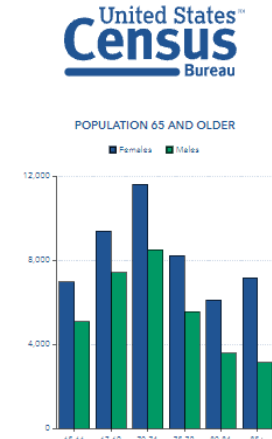

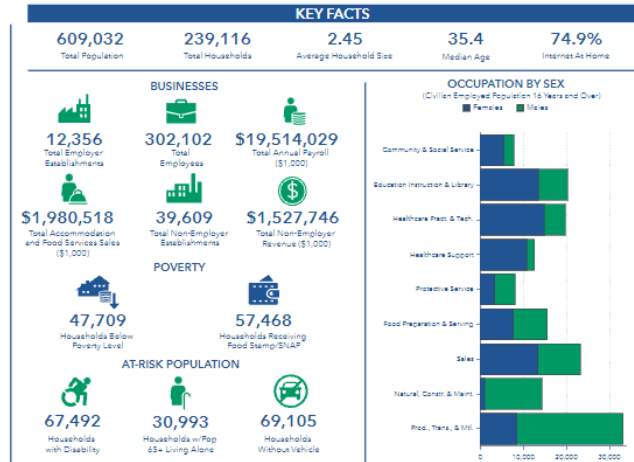


COUNTY COVID-19 IMPACT PLANNING REPORT

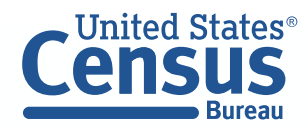
