

TPB Technical Committee Meeting Highlights**October 3, 2008**

The Technical Committee met on October 3 at COG. Six items were reviewed for inclusion on the TPB agenda on October 15.

- TPB agenda Item 7

The Committee was briefed on the call for projects document for the 2009 CLRP and FY 2010-2015 TIP and schedule for the air quality conformity assessment. It also was briefed on revisions to the Congestion Management Documentation portion of the CLRP project description form. The Committee recommended that the TPB approve the document.

- TPB agenda Item 8

The Committee was briefed on the status of the TLC Program and proposed changes to the TLC project application and selection process for FY 2009. The Committee provided comments on the proposed changes and recommended that the TPB release the Call for TLC Project Applications for FY 2009 with an application deadline of December 19, 2008.

- TPB agenda Item 10

The Committee was briefed on the projects in the draft 2008 CLRP, the amendments to the FY 2009-2014 TIP with NVTA funded projects delayed or removed, and the associated air quality conformity assessment. The Committee recommended that the draft plan, TIP and conformity assessment be released for public comment at the TPB Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting on October 9, 2008.

- TPB agenda Item 11

The Committee was briefed on the evaluation of the Fall 2007 and Spring 2008 campaigns, and on the status of the funding and planning for the Fall 2008 and Spring 2009 campaigns.

- TPB agenda Item 12

Staff briefed the Committee on California measure SB375, which will require that transportation plans developed by the metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) in California include strategies designed to achieve certain goals for the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions from automobiles and light trucks.

- TPB agenda Item 13

The Committee was updated on the development of the "CLRP Aspirations" and "What Would It Take" transportation and land use scenarios to be reviewed at the October 15 TPB Scenario Task Force meeting.

Two items were presented for information and discussion:

- Staff briefed the Committee on the survey methodology and the quantity and

quality of the travel data recently obtained from approximately 11,500 randomly selected households in the TPB region and adjacent areas.

- Staff briefed the Committee on an updated list of priority regional bicycle and pedestrian projects recommended for consideration in the FY 2010-2015 TIP by the Bicycle and Pedestrian Subcommittee of the TPB Technical Committee.
