TOUR SITE

- [Breewood Tributary Restoration](#) at 10812 Tenbrook Drive Silver Spring, MD.
- This guided tour will include stream restoration, green streets, and environmental site design (ESD) on both residential and faith based properties, as well as the Rainscapes program.
- Note: This tour location is different than the initial meeting location. We will first be meeting at 10:00 A.M. at the Department of Environmental Protection (255 Rockville Pike Suite 120).
- Tour will be from ~11:30 A.M.-1:30 P.M.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS/PARKING/CAR POOLING

- Put 10812 Tenbrook Drive, Silver Spring, MD 20901 into GPS and park along the street.

APPROPRIATE DRESS & PREPARATIONS FOR WEATHER

- This tour is not on pavement for the whole time.
- We will be walking through “woods” and grass for while we are touring the stream restoration; it could be muddy as well.
- We may be standing in the sun for periods of time.
- Please dress for field conditions. We recommend enclosed shoes or boots, long pants, hat, sunscreen, and insect repellent to ensure protection against ticks and mosquitos.
- Please bring water in case it is warm, and rain coats if rain is in the forecast.
