San Francisco Bay Clean Water, Pollution Prevention and Habitat Restoration Measure was approved in the San Francisco Bay Area region of California and became law on June 7, 2016. The measure is a local tax - approved across the nine counties - to fund coastal habitat restoration and adaptations to sea level rise and flooding. The purpose of the measure as it relates to the San Francisco Bay is to benefit future generations by reducing trash, improving water quality, restoring habitat for fish, birds, and wildlife, reducing flood risk, and increasing shoreline public access and recreational areas."
