
### TPB's FY 2019 UPWP at a glance...

- MPO Revenue and MPO Expenditures the budget is balanced!
- Board action:
  - o FY 2018 Amendment
  - Carryover funding from FY 2018 to FY 2019
  - Approve FY 2019 UPWP



#### **MPO Federal Responsibilities**

- Forum for regional coordination
- Prepare plans and programs that the federal government must approve in order for federal-aid transportation funds to flow to metropolitan Washington
- Provide technical resources for decision-making





#### **Unified Planning Work Program Revenue**

- Federal Funding 80%: FHWA PL and FTA Section 5303
- State 10% match (state DOT funding) and Local 10% (COG dues)
- The total budget for FY 2019 comes from 3 "buckets" of funding:
  - "New" fiscal year funding (Federal FY 2018)
  - "Old" funding from last year's UPWP (FY 2017) obligated to the MPO but not spent (called "unexpended")
  - "Carryover" funding from current year UPWP (FY 2018) that we anticipate not being able to spend by June 30 2018 into FY 2019



## **UPWP** Funding

- Table 1
  - Total UPWP revenues: \$15.9 million
- Table 2
  - Total UPWP expenditures: \$15.9 million
- FY 2018 Amendment (carry over)



#### **Next Steps**

- March 21 TPB actions include:
  - Amend 2018 UPWP to remove funding to be "carried over" to FY 2019
  - Action to approve "carryover" funding from FY 2018 to FY 2019
  - Approval of FY 2019 UPWP
