A number of recent localized developments, including the issuance of a new MS4 permit in Montgomery County, the issuance of a draft MS4 permit for the District of Columbia and the issuance of a draft "flowbased" TMDL for Accotink Creek in Fairfax County, appear to be setting precedents for a stricter regulatory approach to meeting water quality goals. After an introduction by COG staff, selected committee members will discuss the implications of these developments for COG's member governments.
