Two components:

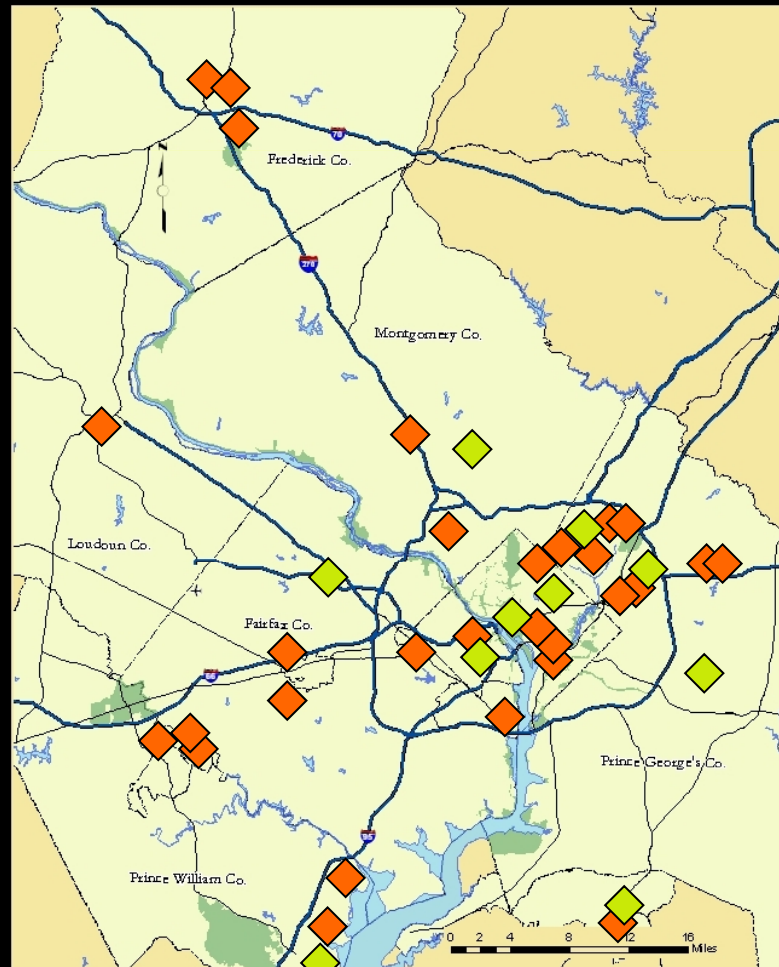

## Projects address common challenges:

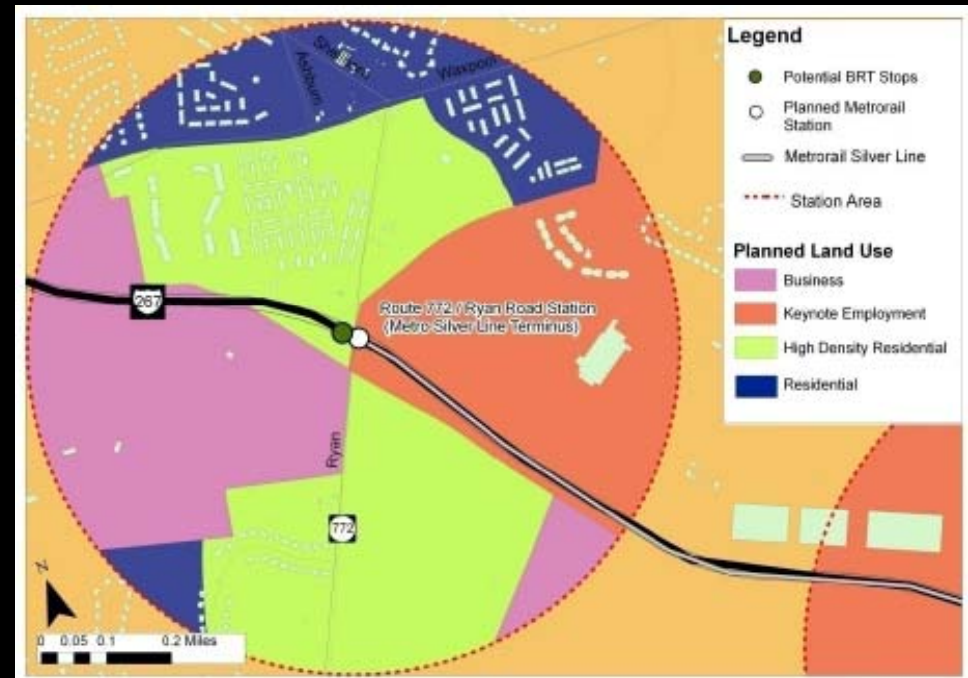
- Bike/Ped Issues

## Past TLC Projects of Interest

### *Bus Rapid Transit Feasibility Study, Leesburg/Loudoun County, Virginia*

- This analysis looked at the potential for Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) from Leesburg to the terminus of the Dulles Metrorail extension.





## **Past TLC Projects of Interest**

### ***Independent Shuttle Bus Consolidation Strategy for Brookland, District of Columbia***

- **The goal of the project is to streamline various existing shuttle services in the Brookland area to reduce costs, decrease traffic and encourage transit use.**
- **The project will address operational issues and provide recommendations for mobility and access improvements around the Brookland Metro.**



## Past TLC Projects of Interest

### *Pedestrian to Transit Accessibility Prioritization Project, Prince George's County, Maryland*

- The project will identify priorities for pedestrian access and safety improvements at bus stops within a mile and a half of Prince George's County's 15 Metrorail stations and at the future Langley Park Transit Center.

- The TPB is expected to approve the panel's project recommendations on July 21, 2010.
