#### The Census Data API

- Application Programming Interface
- Data Service
- Enables data providers to expose data in a standardized way
- Enables software developers to use Census
   Bureau data within their applications

#### **Advantages**


- Reduces the learning curve by standardizing across multiple datasets
- Access only the variables and geographies needed
- No need to host data on another server
- Gives immediate access to most current data
- No complex interface

#### Uses

Supports mobile and web applications

Drives interactive data visualizations

Connects to statistical analysis software like R

- Uses your preferences to create a list of top 25 places and gives you information about each one.
- Uses the GPS feature in your phone to provide you with statistics for your current location.

- Share the app with your friends so that they can find their 25 ideal places.


