Update on Round 6.3 Cooperative ForecastsCOG Staff

During the December 13, 2002 meeting, PDTAC members recommended that, beginning with Round 6.3, the COG Board officially adopt the Cooperative Forecasts concurrently with the Transportation Planning Board's (TPB) approval of the results of the annual Air Quality Conformity Analysis of the TIP and CLRP. The Metropolitan Development Policy Committee (MDPC) is to discuss this change to the approval process during their meeting on Wednesday, January 8, 2003. Staff will report on comments received during the MDPC meeting as well as on the current status of the Round 6.3 Cooperative Forecasts.

During the December 13, 2002 meeting, PDTAC members reviewed elements of several potential alternative growth scenarios which were discussed later that day at the Regional Mobility and Accessibility Joint Working Group. The Metropolitan Development Policy Committee (MDPC) has requested that one scenario include the new Loudoun and Prince George's County comprehensive plans, and that the Regional Activity Centers / Clusters should be used for preparing a more "balanced" job and housing scenario.
