**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ANACOSTIA WATERSHED MARINE DEBRIS – ANACOSTIA
TRASH STRATEGY AND CLEANUP COMMITMENT PROPOSAL**

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) is a nationally recognized leader in watershed restoration and has provided coordination, management, technical and administrative support for the Anacostia restoration effort since 1987; and

WHEREAS, COG has a continuing interest in the restoration, management, monitoring and protection of the Anacostia River and its tributaries; and

WHEREAS, COG has over eight years of experience working with government, public and private organizations in developing Anacostia trash reduction strategies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:**

The Executive Director, or his designee, is authorized to submit a grant proposal to the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) entitled "Anacostia Trash Strategy and Cleanup Commitment" for an amount not to exceed \$25,000. No COG matching funds are required. The project duration will be 12 months.
