Special Session on State, Regional, Local Agency Engagement on Electrification

It was a very well attended special session on Regional, State, and Local Agency Engagement on Transportation Electrification.

Carrie Giles (ICF) discussed federal and state framework for EV infrastructure funding.

Jeff King talked about the development of a Regional EV Deployment Plan. Brian Booher briefed members on Montgomery county's zero emission vehicle program.

Tim Shepherd and Virginia Burke said that a lot of webinars and public engagement are going on Alternative fuels corridors. They talked about the development of a Zero Emission Vehicle Infrastructure Plan.
