RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA TO COMPLETE A HAZARD IDENTIFICATION, RISK ASSESSMENT, IMPACT ANALYSIS AND CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE STRATEGY BENCHMARKING FOR THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG) serves as the Secretariat for the Urban Area Security Initiative for the National Capital Region; and

WHEREAS, COG has been requested by the State Administrative Agent (SAA) and the Emergency Managers Committee to obtain the services of a Contractor to complete a Hazard Identification, Risk Assessment (HIRA), Impact Analysis and Critical Infrastructure Strategy Benchmarking for the National Capital Region; and

WHEREAS, the District of Columbia has agreed to provide supplemental funding to COG; and

WHEREAS, SRA International has been selected through a competitive solicitation process to complete the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE METROPOLITAN WASHINGTON COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

The Executive Director or his designee is authorized to execute both the supplemental funding agreement from the District of Columbia in the amount of \$1.2 million and the contract with SRA International in the amount of \$200K to complete a Hazard Identification, Risk Assessment, Impact Analysis and Critical Infrastructure Strategy Benchmarking for the District of Columbia. Additional task orders will be authorized to contractor in an amount not to exceed total funding provided by the District of Columbia. No COG matching funds will be required.
