

THRESHOLDS FOR REPORTING


- Primary Thresholds:
 - National Weather Service (NWS)-issued Winter Storm Warning
 - State of Emergency or Disaster Declaration
- Secondary or Cascading Impacts:
 - Critical Infrastructure impacts with consequences expected to last or lasting longer than one (I) hour or requiring significant human services support
 - Significant regional consequences that trigger additional CIRs (Transportation, COOP/COG, Emergency Declaration)
- Types of Winter Weather:
 - Snow or Ice Storms
 - Flooding, Freezing Rain, High Winds
 - Severe Cold Closings (Schools)





OPERATIONAL POSTURE & REPORTING

- Pre-Incident Planning and Posture:
 - 72 / 48 / 24hr storm pre-incident notice from National Weather Service (NWS)
 - Initial RICCS Alert released after NWS issues Winter Storm Warning
 - Outlines the Battle Rhythm
 - Participation in Conference Calls
 - Initial SITREP release
- Incident Posture:
 - Leverage information from NCR Jurisdictions, MATOC, VDEM Region VII, and MJOC
 - Issuance of SITREPs (4hr, or as necessary)
 - Continued participation in Conference Calls
 - Coordination with FEMA-ONCRC
- Post-Incident:
 - Closeout of SITREPs
 - After-Action Review



The Winter Weather Advisory for the NCR was cancelled at approximately 5AM. No more snowfall is expected in the NCR.

All NCR School are closed or virtual today, with many governments operating at a delayed opening. Federal offices in the Washington, DC area are closed, with emergency employees and telework employees continuing










HSIN NCR OPERATIONS CHAT ROOM
