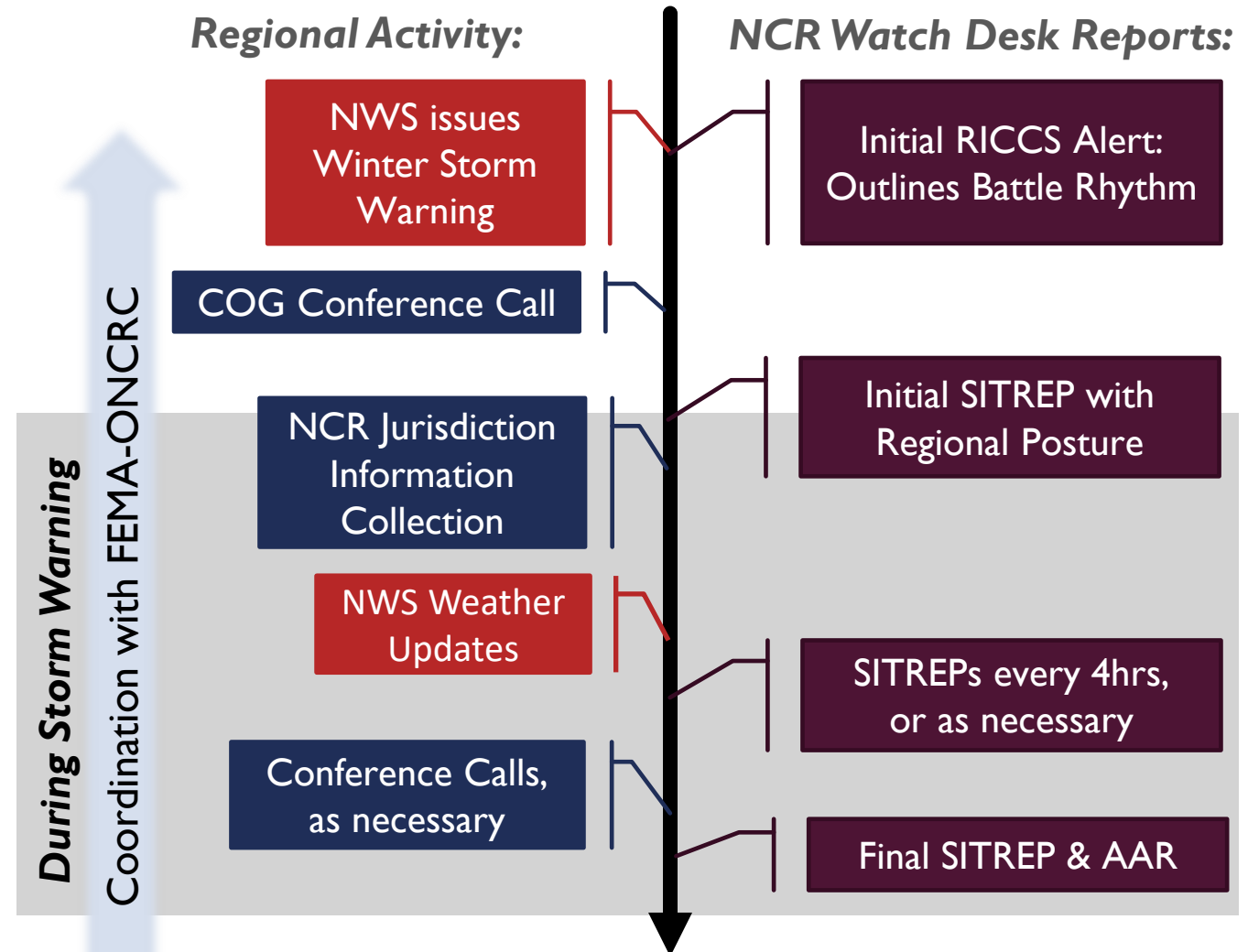
THRESHOLDS FOR REPORTING

- Primary Thresholds:
 - National Weather Service (NWS)-issued Winter Storm Warning
 - State of Emergency or Disaster Declaration
- Secondary or Cascading Impacts:
 - Critical Infrastructure impacts with consequences expected to last or lasting longer than one (1) hour or requiring significant human services support
 - Significant regional consequences that trigger additional CIRs (Transportation, COOP/COG, Emergency Declaration)
- Types of Winter Weather:
 - Snow or Ice Storms
 - Flooding, Freezing Rain, High Winds
 - Severe Cold Closings (Schools)



OPERATIONAL POSTURE & REPORTING

- Pre-Incident Planning and Posture:
 - 72 / 48 / 24hr storm pre-incident notice from National Weather Service (NWS)

The Winter Storm Warning issued by the National Weather Service (NWS) is in effect for the National Capital Region from 1AM Wednesday to 7PM Wednesday. The warning for Loudoun and Frederick County will be in effect until 1AM Thursday. Flurries are forecast to start at 5AM, turn to heavy snow at 10AM, and from 10AM until 12PM steady sleet is expected. Temperatures to rise above freezing later in the day.

Maryland:

- MDOT began anti-icing roads on Monday and finished today.
- Full crew deployment starting at 1AM, upstanding between the hours of 2AM and 4AM.

- Prince William County Omni Ride will have limited buses.
- Fairfax Connector will operate on a Saturday schedule Wednesday.
- Maryland MTA has suspended all commuter bus service.

Rail:

Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA):

- Operations level 3 by 4AM.
- The system will operate regular hours from 5 a.m. until 11:30 p.m. All stations will be open.
- For safety reasons, the top levels of all Metro parking garages will be closed.
- Advising customers that trains will run every 12 minutes out of terminals.
- Metro bus will operate on a severe snow service plan providing limited service on major roadways only.
- Metro Access service for customers with disabilities will be limited to "return home" trips only on Wednesday between 4 a.m. and 7 p.m. All other trips will be canceled.

MARC:

- MARC will operate on a reduced schedule on the Penn and Camden lines. The Brunswick line has been cancelled.

Virginia Railway Express (VRE):

- All service are cancelled for Wednesday February 20.

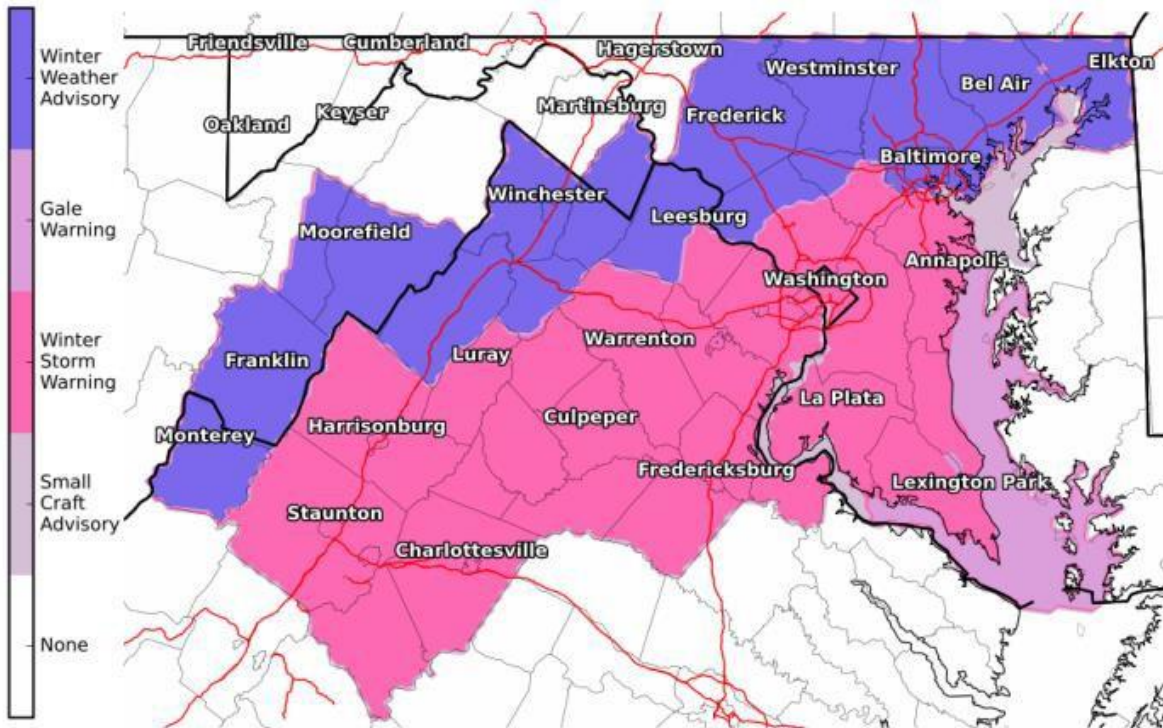

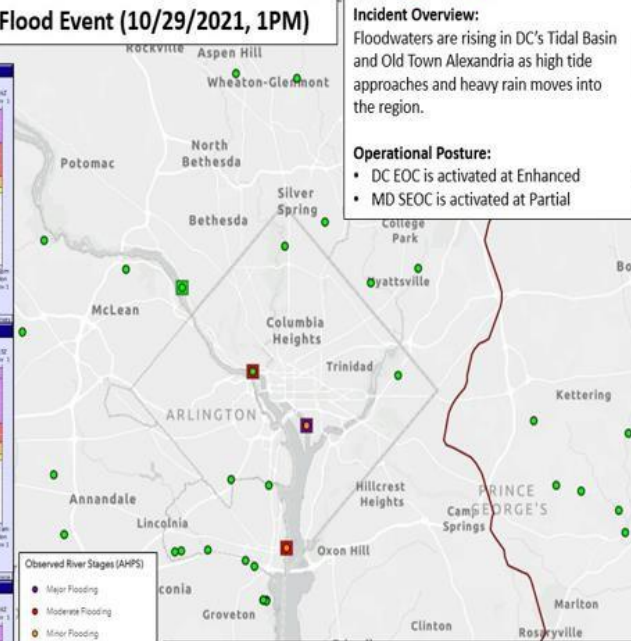

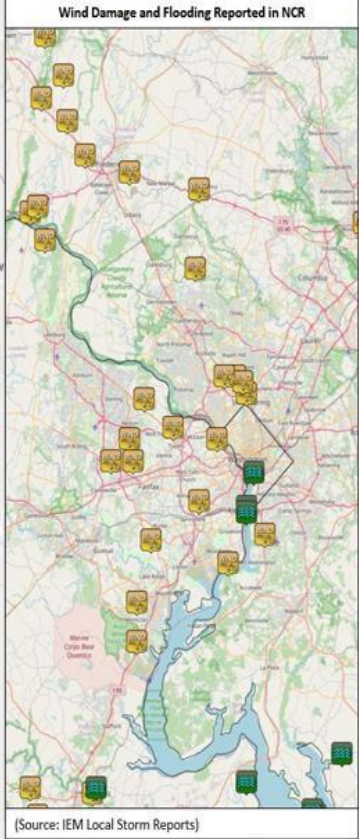
Incident Overview:
Floodwaters are rising in DC's Tidal Basin and Old Town Alexandria as high tide approaches and heavy rain moves into the region.

Operational Posture:

- DC EOC is activated at Enhanced
- MD SEOC is activated at Partial

Damage Reported/Impacts:

- Gusty winds of up to around 40 mph combined with wet ground from recent rainfall is resulting in sporadic tree and power line damage
- No major traffic implications
- Prince George's County Public Schools closing 1 hour early
- Fairfax County: 4,759 power outages, as of 12:45PM (mainly impacting Tysons)
