Ride for the Region Challenge - Context

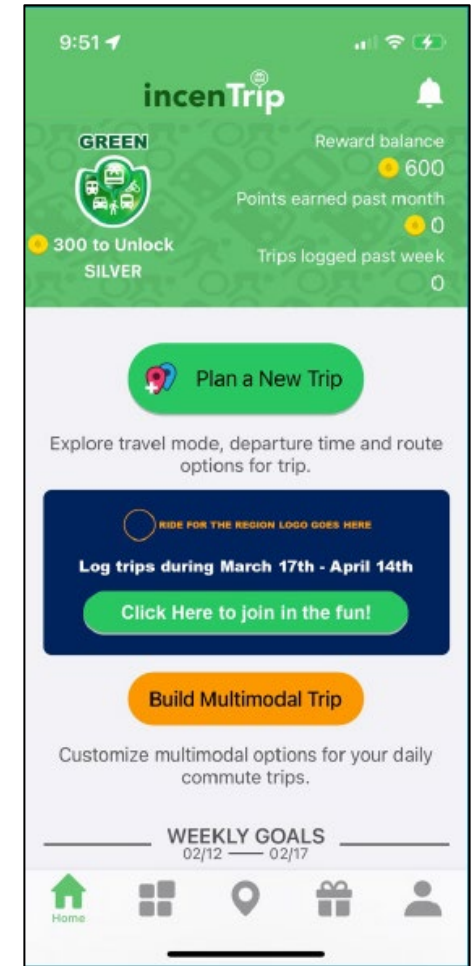
- Concept developed by a task force led by WMATA and Advanced Energy Group in fall 2023.

Ride for the Region Challenge - Operations



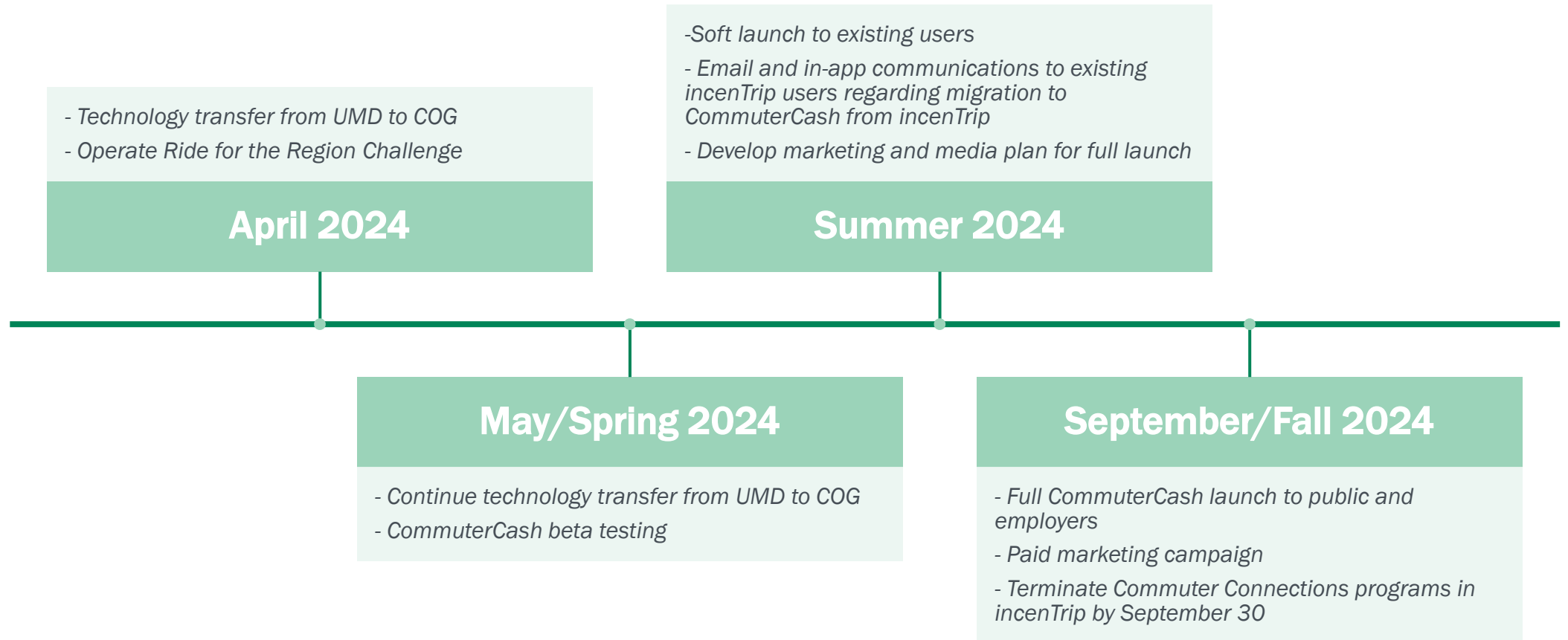
Ride for the Region Challenge - Operations
