WHEREAS, the State Administrative Agent has provided Urban Area Security Initiative funding to COG to support the development and conduct of a Volunteer Reception Center Regional Exercise and to provide support to Volunteer Centers in accordance with the Project Management Plan to improve preparedness in the region as approved by the Chief Administrative Officers and the Senior Policy Group.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DI RECTORS OF THE METROPOLI TAN WASHI NGTON COUNCI L OF GOVERNMENTS THAT:

The Executive Director, or his designee, is authorized to enter into a contract with a consulting firm for $\$ 79,760$ for the development and conduct of the Volunteer Reception Center Regional Exercise and to reimburse Volunteer Centers for $\$ 17,800$ in associated personnel and supply costs. Funds have been allocated to COG for this initiative by the State Administrative Agent for the National Capital Region. No matching COG funds are required.
