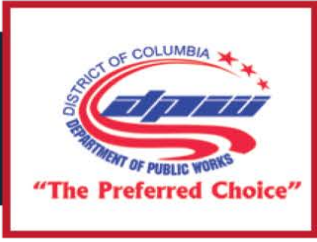

- Inspection of Equipment and Vehicles

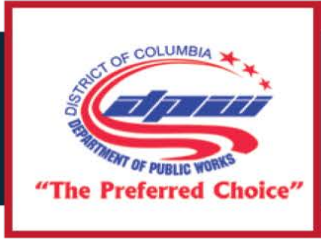
1 Day in Advance:

- Snow Emergency Declared

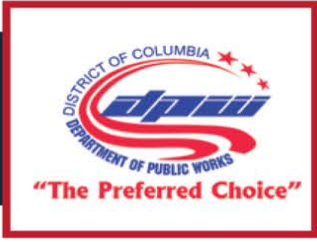

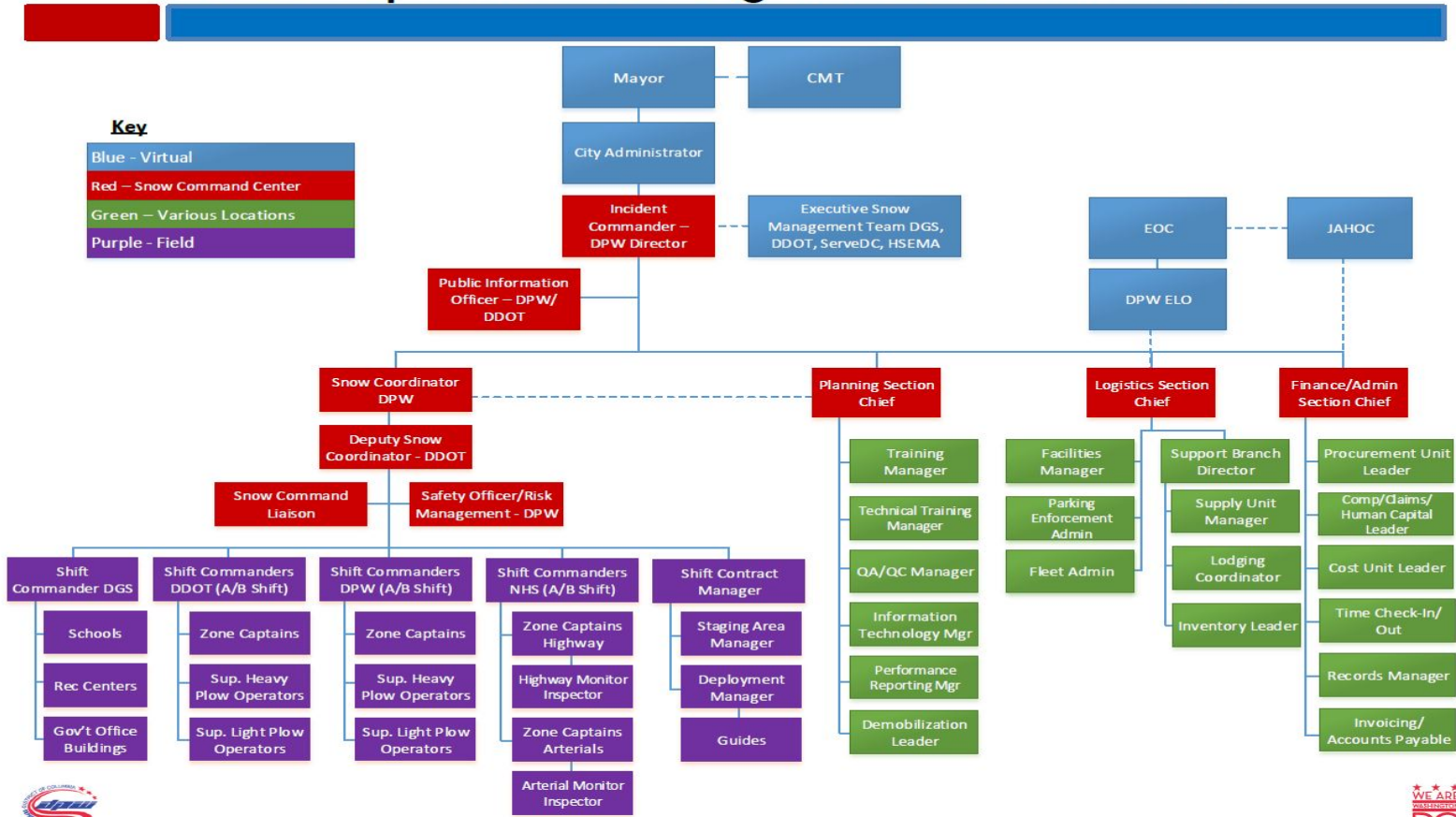


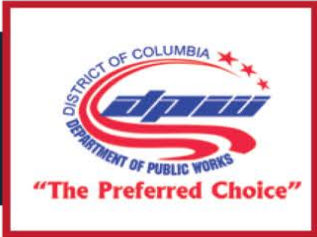

Snow Operations Organization Structure



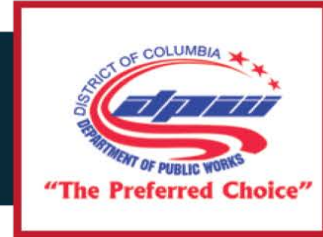


Winter Preparation Timeline





Snow Disposal Locations

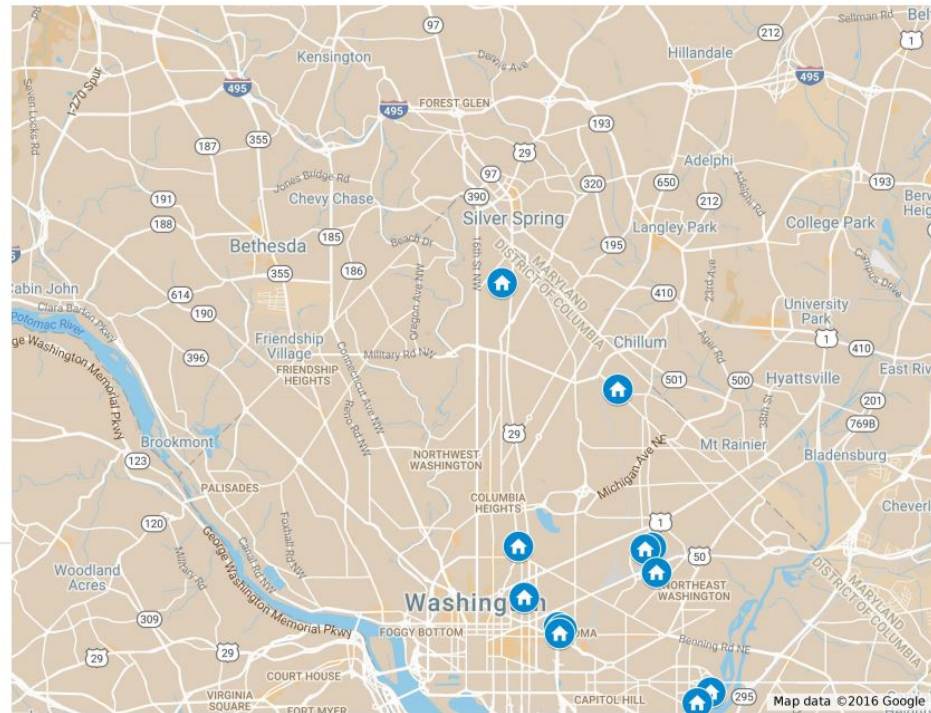

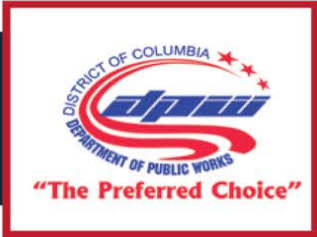
