American Rescue Plan

- Child Tax Credit is expected to cut child poverty in half!
 - \$3,600 for children younger than 6, and \$3,000 for children younger than 18
 - Fully refundable making all low-income households eligible for the full benefit
 - Provides advance payments throughout the year starting in July
 - IRS must establish an online portal for taxpayers to update relevant data for mid-year payment adjustments, such as birth of a child



American Rescue Plan

- Extends Pandemic EBT to provide benefits during the summer through the course of the pandemic
 - Provides \$6.82 daily
 - For every child who is eligible for free or reduced-price schools or who attends a Community Eligibility or Provision 2/3 during the summer
 - Eligible school children not attending school in person full time
 - Children under 6 in SNAP households in areas where schools or childcare have reduced in person operations
 - DC plan approved for school age and childcare; Virginia plan approved for school age; Maryland has not been approved yet.
 - Pave the way for EBT program for kids?



What About Meals?

- Schools, government agencies and private nonprofits have been able to provide meals to all children through USDA child nutrition waivers through September 30.
- ARP did not extend USDA's authority to issue waivers, but the authority remains through September 30.
- Asking USDA to extend the waivers through school year 2021-2022
- Supports post pandemic vision of Healthy School Meals for All
