

MEETING NOTES CAR FREE DAY 2011 STEERING COMMITTEE Wednesday September 14, 2011

1. Introductions

2. Approval of Minutes from July 13, 2011 Meeting Minutes were approved as written.

3. Poster/Transit Signage

Posters were distributed by the end of July and included the QR code and listed the grand prizes of an iPad and bicycle. Commuter Connections sent the posters to 7,000 employers within the region. Complimentary signage placement was provided for Car Free Day by the following transit agencies: Arlington Transit, Fairfax Connector, Frederick County TransIT, Montgomery County Ride On, and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority. Commuter Connections paid for the printing.

4. Radio/Press Releases

"Smell the Roses" was the draft radio script selected by the Committee among a choice of three. The spot encourages listeners to take the time to notice the sounds of birds chirping instead of cars honking, and instead smelling car exhaust to stop and smell the roses. The radio spot was produced in first half of August, and started airing during the last week of August and will continue through the third week in September. The finished radio spot was played for the Committee. Four Car Free Day press releases were sent by Commuter Connections; the first beginning in August, announcing that registration had opened and the most recent was about Car Free Day surpassing its pledge goal.

- Bike and Roll is offering free bicycle rentals on Car Free Day.
- Montgomery College Rockville Campus is hosting "Bike to College Day", with free giveaways and prize drawings on Car Free Day.
- Montgomery County Commuter Services is providing coffee & donuts on the morning of Car Free Day at the Burtonsville Park and Ride Lot.
- Loudoun County Office of Transportation Services is raffling off prizes for anyone who either lives or works in the County and pledges.
- In celebration of Car Free Day Sport&health clubs are offering a free 7-day pass good thru the end of September.
