Timeline 2009-2013:

2009 - City begins researching bikeshare.

2012 - City and University jointly apply and receive state bikeshare funding.

2013 - C & U enter negotiations to join Capital Bikeshare.

Timeline 2013-2016:

mBike

Dec. 2013 - CaBi equipment supply delays jeopardize grant funding.

April 2015 - C & U issue joint RFP for a bikeshare system.

June 2015 - C & U select Zagster.

May 2016 - mBike launches with 14 stations & 125 bicycles.






