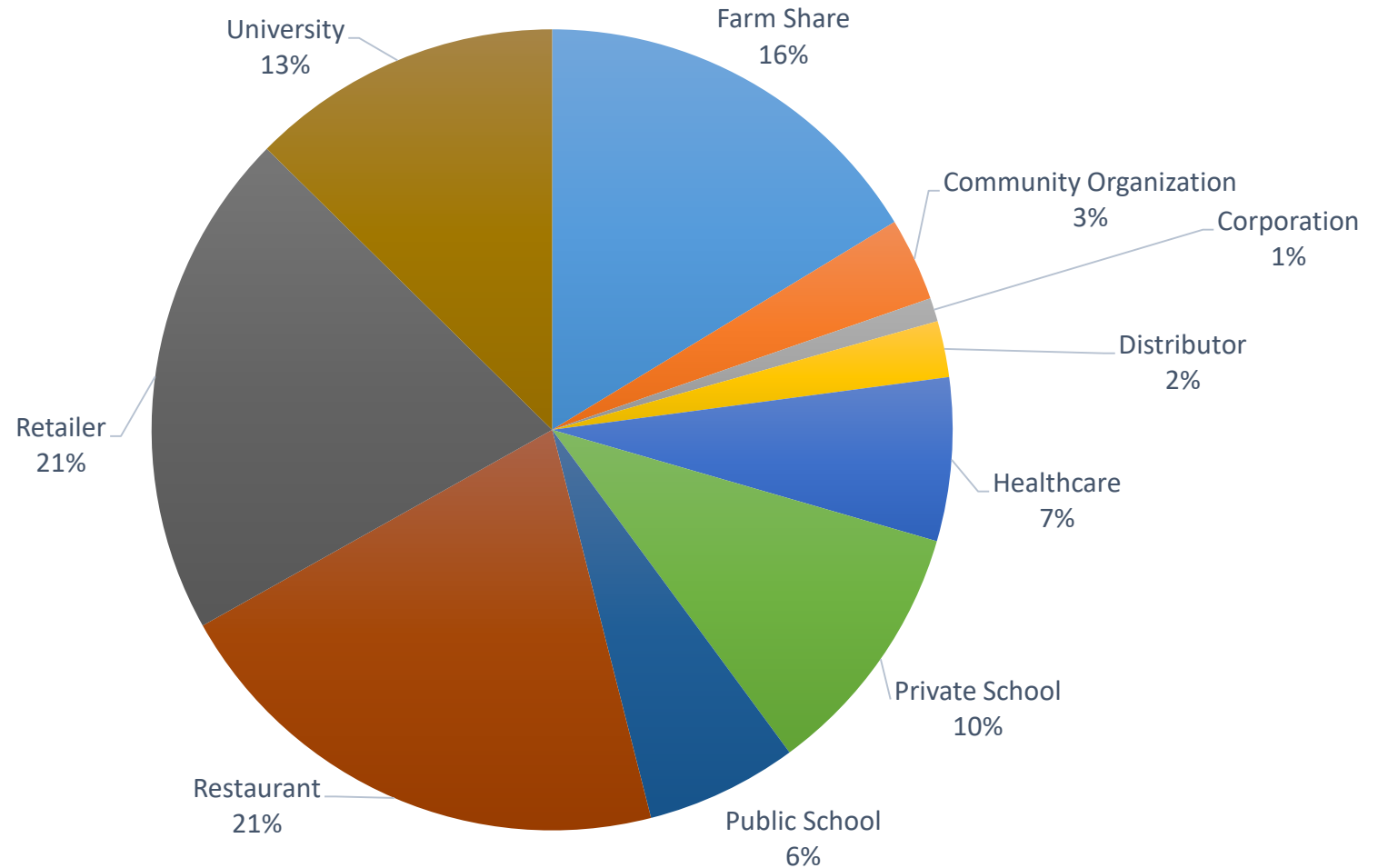

2017 Sales breakdown by Customer Segment



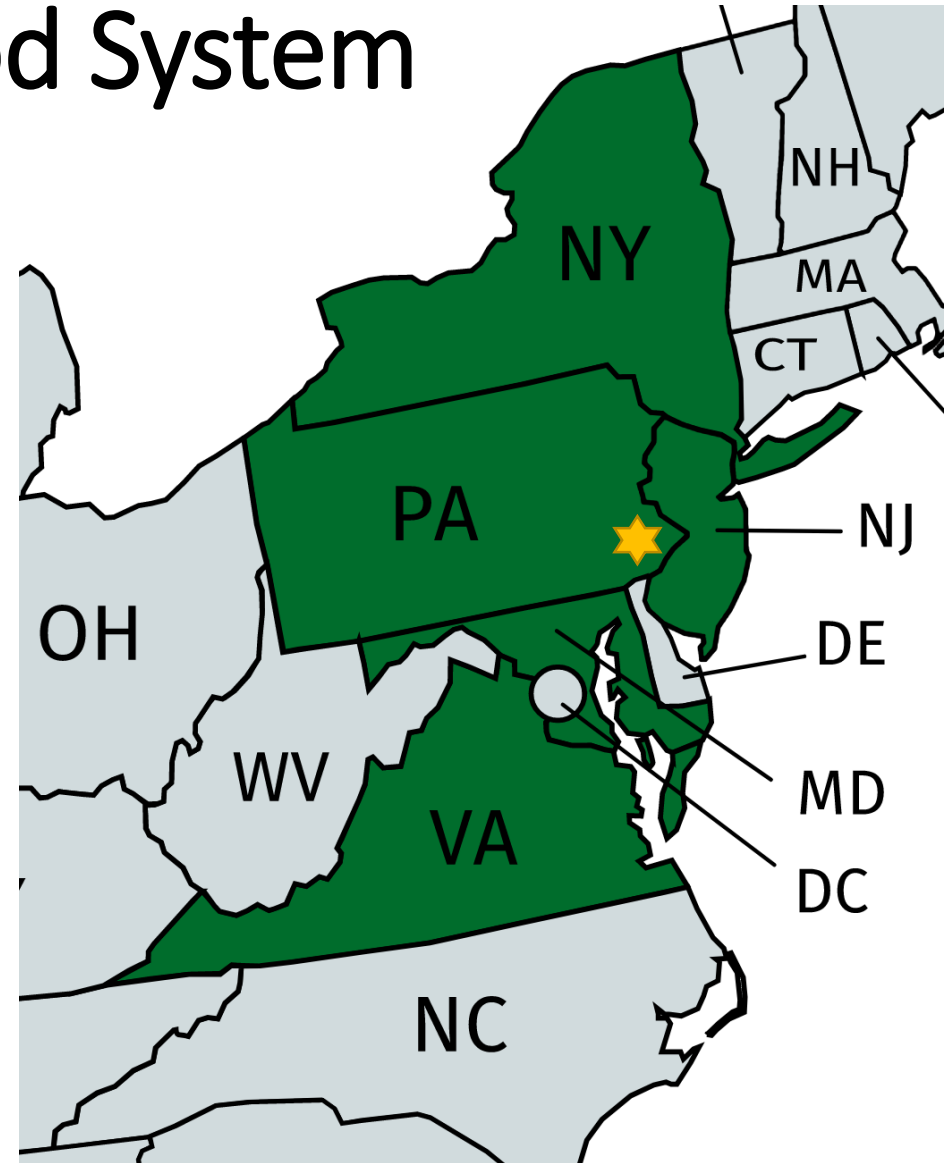
Challenges
