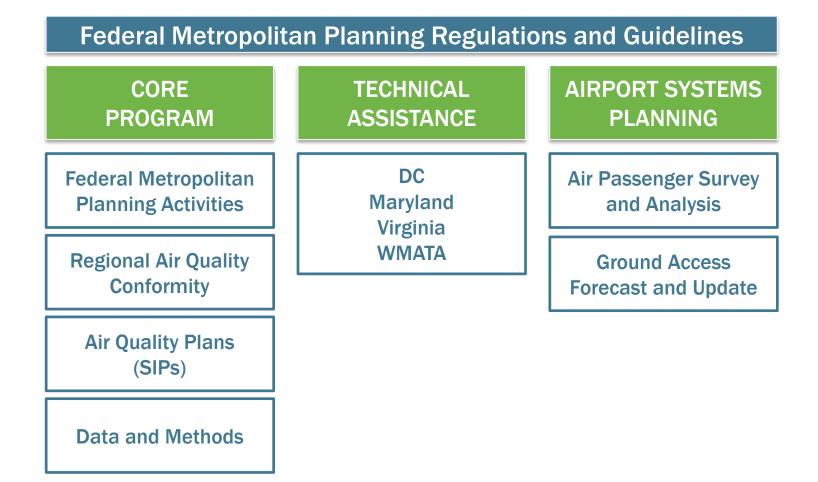


What is the UPWP?

- TPB's annual work program and budget
 - Federally mandated work activities
 - Additional regional planning activities
 - Federally assisted state, regional, and local planning activities
- Required as a basis and condition for all federal funding for transportation planning at the MPO and State levels
- Continues and builds upon activities in current program
 - Advances work activities toward MAP-21 planning requirements
- **NEW** Preparing for requirements of FAST Act

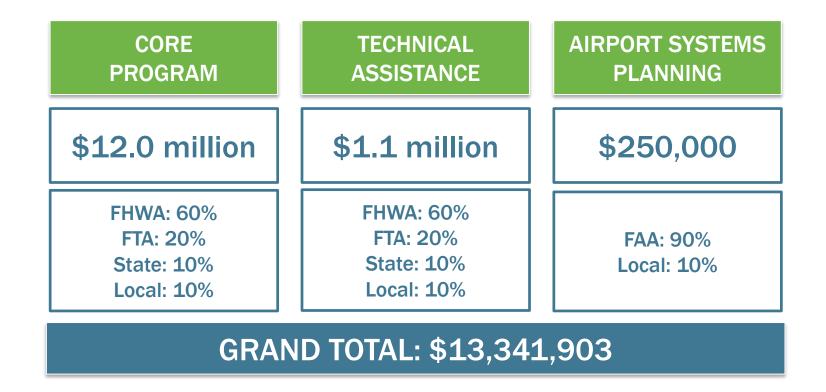


How is the UPWP Structured?

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Key Assumptions for FY 2017

- New Planning Funds same as amended FY 2016 UPWP
- Retain ongoing activities and initiatives from FY 2016
- Regroup activities for functional synergies
- Does not include any anticipated FY 2016 Carryover Funding or additional funding under FAST Act
 - Consequently, draft FY 2017 UPWP budget is 13% less than current FY 2016 UPWP.
- Funding amendment anticipated in the fall once federal and state budget levels are finalized

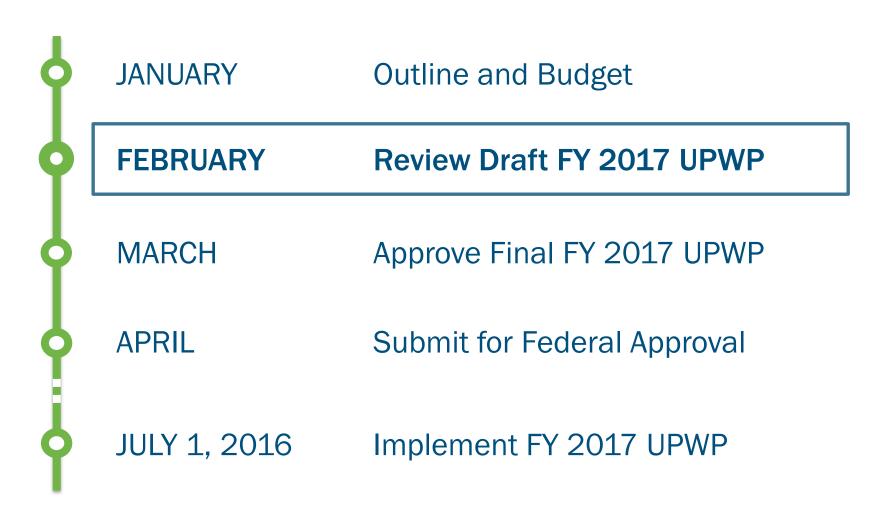
